## Interim Election of a Parent Governor

The Instrument of Government for Castle Rushen High School provides for the inclusion of a Parent Governor on the School's Governing Body.

It is now necessary to hold an interim election and you will find accompanying this letter a nomination form which contains all of the relevant details.

To stand, propose, assent or vote in the election a parent must be the parent of a child who is a registered pupil at the School at the date of the election. For the purposes of the election, the term "parent" includes any person who has parental responsibility for a child and any person with whom a child is living and who has care of him or her. Within a family each parent may vote but parents do not have extra votes because they have more than one child in the School.

As Headteacher of the School, I am the Returning Office for the election.

Any parent who wishes to stand as a candidate should have the nomination form duly completed and ensure that it is returned to me by the date indicated on the form.
