
Uniform Castle Rushen High School : Sixth Form

General principles

1. Sixth formers are role models and should always look SMART overall, as well as ensuring their uniform complies with the “Colour and Components – requirements for Sixth Form”
2. No casual clothing, for example hoodies, lycra, denim, leggings, trainers, chunky jumpers or items with logos
3. No extreme hairstyles
4. Jewellery and make-up are allowed provided discreet and safe
5. The final decision on all uniform related matters including whether a student is smart enough rests with the Head of Sixth Form, who will consult with the Headteacher as necessary.

Colours and Components – requirements for Sixth Form

Our uniform colour palette is **Black, Grey or Navy**. All items must be **Plain and only of these colours** unless patterns or other colours are stated below.

The uniform comprises:

1. **A suit comprising i) a jacket and ii) full length trousers or, for females, a skirt, dress or culottes.** i) and ii) do not have to be the same colour, and a subtle pinstripe or checked pattern is allowed.
2. **A shirt/blouse**, additionally allowed to be White. For females, a smart thin polo neck or other smart thin top is allowed, provided the item is not low-cut and does not show midriff, and a subtle pattern is allowed. For males, a Blue shirt is allowed but a Black shirt is not.
3. **Males must wear a school tie**
4. **Low-heeled shoes**, additionally allowed to be Brown
5. Females wearing skirts or dresses should also wear plain tights, additionally allowed to be Neutral colour
6. If wearing trousers, plain socks are required. These may be of any colour.
7. Thin knitwear is allowed to be worn under the jacket if desired. For males, this needs to leave the shirt collar and top of the school tie clearly visible.
