
Baggage Allowance

Les Flocons Vert – Les Carroz

- Les Flocons Verts is situated beside the slopes in Les Carroz. Just 100m from the beginners' area and the lifts. The hotel is built seamlessly into the slope side and is an award winning design.
- All rooms are en-suite and include continental breakfast, hot lunches in your hotel and 3-course evening meals. You do also have the option of packed lunches instead of coming back to the hotel.


Rooms

The skiing


- 5 days x 5 hours skiing (students will not be permitted to ski unless they are accompanied by the instructors)
- All skiing is in instructor led groups
- Groups split by ability
- Skis, boots, poles and helmet rental provided
- Grand Massif offers 265km of well-groomed skiable terrain. This means there's a wide selection of challenging runs for skiers of every level.

A typical day

- Lastly.... Your 'Minions' fancy dress costume


Daily Post




- 1. Yes, the hotel has WIFI
